Absolutism, Scientific Revolution and Enlightenment Curry Samara

The Curry Samara is a learning unit that uses Bloom's Taxonomy to give students the opportunity to show their understanding of material on multiple levels of learning. From the most basic (knowledge) to the most complex (critical thinking), this unit is designed to allow students' choice in their learning and in the products they choose to produce.

For each of the three topics (Absolutism, The Scientific Revolution and The Enlightenment) – students will complete multiple squares, one that will be chosen for them and two of their own choosing. Each student must complete the 'knowledge' square and then are free to choose two more from each row. The items that students will produce to show their understanding/mastery of the information questioned in each square are found **bolded** at the bottom of each square. All three assignments are due by the end of the week for each topic as follows:

- Week 1: Absolutism

o Tuesday, November 14 – Wednesday, November 22

- Week 2: The Scientific Revolution

o Monday, November 27 – Friday, December 1

- Week 3: The Enlightenment

o Monday, December 4 – Friday, December 8

Grading for this unit is as follows:

- The "Knowledge" Square for each will count as a daily grade.
- The assignments turned in for each of the three groups (Absolutism, Sci. Rev. and Enlightenment) will count as ONE QUIZ Grade
- ALL THREE groupings will be combined to count as ONE TEST Grade
